# Rear Window by Axel GOMO

**A series of minimal drone ambient improvisations performed during the Parisian lockdown 2020.**

Confined at home with a prepared guitar, objects, delays, and a microphone that records through the rear window, Axel Gomo takes his inspiration from the murmur of Paris Paul Verlaine's prison poem *Le ciel est par-dessus le toit* and music innovators like William Basinski, Morton Feldman, Luc Ferrari, Eliane Radigue, Sunn O))), zoviet\*france: and their *Duck in a tree* broadcast on Resonance FM, ...
